The Moses Family from Ropperhausen (Grossropperhausen) and Frielendorf

The only **Moses** we know about Ropperhausen was named in a tax-list from 20.07.1675, There is written, that he emigrated emigrated from Vienna where all Jews had been expelled in 1671. He settled in Ropperhausen since 1674 under protection of Rudolf von Gilsa. His son **Hirsch Moses**, was born in 1676 in Ropperhausen. Hirsch Moses' oldest son moved to Neukirchen, from where the descendants emigrated into the USA. His second son **Moses Hirsch**, born 1712, got a protective letter for Ropperhausen after his father died.
