Leopold Marx was arrested in Bad Wildungen on 10.11.1938 and deported to Buchenwald. Later from 15.11.1939 he lived in Kassel Koelnische Strasse 51, 10.06.1940: Giessbergstrasse 2 and 26.05.1941 Koelnische Strasse 65. He was deported on 09.12.1941 from Kassel to Riga and from there on 05.11.1943 to Auschwitz. In 2006 a Stolperstein was dedicated to him in Bad Wildungen, Kornstrasse 3.

Albert said send Jacob to us since the Germans had not yet invaded Holland and the trip to England/US was too much for Jacob at his age.“ ...
„They escaped Germany in 1939. Stamps in their passports were dated Marburg May 25, 1939 and on May 26, 1939 they received a Visa (no. 21910) from Frankfurt/Main to leave for England. Another Marburg stamp on August 17, 1939 and on August 20, 1939 arrived at the Vlodropo train station, which lies on the border of Germany and the Dutch province of Limburg. It is unclear as how they got from there to England but assuming, as in the Kindertransport, they travelled to the hook of Holland and then took

the ferry to Harwich, England. Immigration in Harwich, England stamped their passports on August 24, 1939. They lived only one year in England at 79 Finsbury Park Road in London with Adolph Kahn. On February 19th, 1940 they received another Visa and on March 18, 1940 (no. 187238) their exit permit to leave England for the US.
