

**The Salomon - Loewenson – Levisohn – Familie**  
**from Dorla/Obervorschütz/Gudensberg**

**The ancestors of Roeschen Levisohn – Naschelsky**

**First Generation :**

1. **Leib Salomon and Judel nee Levi.** They had two sons:
  - + 2. **Abraham Salomon**, born February 1781 in Dorla, he took in 1808 the surname **Loewenson.**
  - + 3. **Meyer Salomon**, born in December 1785 in Dorla, he took in 1808 the surname **Loewenson.**

**Second Generation :**

2. **Abraham Salomon Loewenson**, born February 1781 in Dorla, he was a merchant, he married **Jettchen, nee Levi.** They had three sons:
  - + 4. **Leib Levisohn**, born 15.09.1816 in Dorla
  - 5. **Aron Levisohn**, born 02.09.1825 in Dorla
  - 6. **Salomon Levisohn**, born 14.11.1828 in Dorla.

Abraham Levisohn died on 20.12.1837 in Dorla. Jettchen Levisohn died on 16.03.1853 in Dorla.

3. **Meyer Salomon Loewenson**, born in December 1785 in Dorla, he married **Biene, nee Schuchhardt.** Meyer and Biene Loewenson / Levisohn had four children:
  - + 7. **Giedel Levisohn**, born 26.05.1826
  - 8. **Marum Levisohn**, born 29.03.1828
  - 9. **Fratchen Levisohn**, born 10.05.1831
  - 10. **Schoenchen Roeschen Levisohn**, born 14.01.1834

Meyer Levisohn died on 20.11.1842 at the age of 56 years. Biene Levisohn died on 05.12.1857 at the age of 72 years.

**Third Generation :**

4. **Leib Levisohn**, born 15.09.1816 in Dorla, he was a merchant, he married first on 20.06.1849 **Mirgam, nee Sauer**, born around 1829/1830 in Lohne, daughter of Emanuel Sauer and his wife Edel, nee Abt. Leib and Mirgam Levisohn had seven children:
  - 11. **Abraham Levisohn**, born 26.05.1850 in Dorla
  - + 12. **Roeschen Levisohn**, born 21.06.1852 in Dorla
  - 13. **Jettchen Levisohn**, born 07.12.1854 in Obervorschuetz
  - 14. **Mendel Levisohn**, born 06.09.1857 in Obervorschuetz, he died 27.09.1858 in Obervorschuetz
  - 15. **Guetchen Levisohn**, born 14.12.1859 in Obervorschuetz

**16. Leiser Levisohn**, born 26.01.1863 in Obervorschuetz, he died 09.02.1863 in Obervorschuetz.

**17. Fanny Levisohn**, born 05.07.1864 in Obervorschuetz.

Mirgam Levisohn died on 04.04.1866 in Obervorschuetz. Leib Levisohn married a second time on 24.05.1868 **Ettel, nee Abt**, born 28.09.1838 in Roehrenfurth, daughter of Leiser Abt and his wife Esther, nee Rosenblatt. Leib and Ettel Levisohn had moved to Gudensberg and Leib became a butcher. They had six children:

**18. Leiser Levisohn**, born 19.11.1868 in Gudensberg, he died 04.12.1868 in Gudensberg

**19. Esther Levisohn**, born 21.12.1869 in Gudensberg

**20. Aron Adolf Levisohn**, born 01.12.1871 in Gudensberg

**21. Moses Levisohn**, born 22.02.1874 in Gudensberg, he died 02.06.1874 in Gudensberg

**22. Sara Levisohn**, born 04.06.1875 in Gudensberg

**23. Gelle, called Emilie Levisohn**, born 15.06.1877 in Gudensberg.

Ettel Levisohn died on 27.09.1892 in Gudensberg. Leib Levisohn died on 08.02.1900 in Gudensberg.

**7. Giedel Levisohn**, born 26.05.1826, she was married on 21.10.1848 to **Daniel Plaut**, born around 1817, son of Marcus Plaut Loewenstein and his wife Braune, nee Abraham. Giedel and Daniel had three children:

**24. Braunchen Plaut**, born 29.11.1849, she died 03.04.1872

**25. Marius Plaut**, born 03.09.1851

**26. Roeschen Plaut**, born 19.03.1854.

Daniel Plaut died on 11.06.1855, Giedel Plaut died on 28.11.1892-

#### **Fourth Generation :**

**12. Roeschen Levisohn**, born 21.06.1852 in Dorla, she married on 08.12.1882 in Gudensberg

**David Naschelsky**, hairdresser, he was born on 08.or 25.08.1849 in Babiak / Russia (today Poland. He was the son of the tailor Jacob / M.J. Naschelsky and his wife Beile, nee Bebraelly / Babiarkin. Roeschen and David Naschelsky had three children:

+ **27. Recha Naschelsky**, born 30.08.1883 in Gudensberg

+ **28. Abraham / Albert Naschelsky**, born 15.06.1885 in Gudensberg

+ **29. Julius Jecheothel Naschelsky**, born 07.08.1887 in Gudensberg.

David Naschelsky died on 26.05.1917 in Gudensberg. Roeschen Naschelsky died on 30.01.1928 Gudensberg.

Michael Elias wrote in an article „Bilder aus einer kleinen Stadt“ 1923 about David Naschelsky: *„Auch zwei Handwerker gab es unter den Mitgliedern der juedischen Gemeinde, abgesehen von den drei Metzgern. Der eine, ein alteingesessener und sehr angesehener Mann, war Buchbinder, der andere, ein zu meiner Zeit dort zufaellig haengen gebliebener Russe, war Friseur. Er kam als Handwerksbursche nach Gudensberg, blieb dort, eroeffnete eine Barbierstube, bekam, da er gesellige Talente hatte, gut Anekdoten zu erzaehlen wusste, und da der einzige Barbier des Staedtchen sich bald nachher im Buergelbrunnen ertraenkte, bald zu tun, verheiratete sich mit der Tochter eines einheimischen Metzgers und wurde mit der Zeit ein beliebter und auch wohlhabender*

*Mann. Er besass große Kenntnisse im hebraeischen Schrifttum, ui d ich habe, als ich mich fuer den Eintritt in das Seminar vorbereitete, bei ihm Unterricht in Raschi, Schulchan, Aruch und Mischna gehabt. “*

### **Fifth Generation :**

**27. Recha Naschelsky**, born 30.08.1883 in Gudensberg, she was married on 27.12.1910 in Gudensberg to **Julius Schoenbach**, merchant, born 23.08.1883 in Cologne, son of Jakob Schoenbach and his wife Rebecca. Recha and Julius Schoenbach had a son:

+ **30. Meno Schoenbach**

The family emigrated into the States. Recha Schoenbach died during the first six weeks in the USA. She is buried in a Wichita cemetery in Woodward Oklahoma. Julius Schoenbach was killed in hurricane in Florida.

**28. Albert Naschelsky**, born 15.06.1885 in Gudensberg. He married **Bertha Plaut**, born 23.07.1887 in Obervorschuetz, daughter of Isaac Plaut and his wife Jannchen, nee Goldschmidt. Albert and Bertha Naschelsky emigrated in the USA. They lived in Oklahoma. They had two children:

**29. Julius Naschelsky**, born 07.08.1887 in Gudensberg, he married on 06.06.1919 **Friederika Elias** born 19.11.1897 in Gudensberg, daughter of Markus Elias and his wife Helene, nee Abt. Julius and Friederika Naschelsky had three children:

**33. Dieter Naschelsky**, born 06.03.1920 in Gudennsberg

**34. Erna Margot Naschelsky**, born 06.07.1921 in Gudensberg

**35. Guenther Martin Naschelsky**, he was born 07.07.1926 in Gudensberg.
