Preface

All of my ancestors, going back at least to 1590, were German Jews – a 350 year legacy. Of that thirteen generation legacy, three were decimated in the Holocaust. In researching my family tree, the magnitude of that personal destruction emerged. How many family members were murdered or lost in that horrible time?

Over 650 family members, including their spouses and children, perished in the Holocaust. Approximately 1,000 other uncles, aunts and cousins were probably living in Europe in the 1930s. I have thus far found no evidence of their fate.

This is one of a series of reports, each based on the descendants of one to four ancestral couples. It details my findings. For those who perished, detailed source information is presented. For those whose fate is unknown, the known, often sparse, details are included. My intention is to spur further efforts to discover the fate of those who may or may not have survived.

This report covers the descendants of Jakob Moyses born before 1736 and his wife Sara who gave birth to the Cahn, Heilberg, Lahrberg, Löwenstein and Stern families of Meudt, Westerwald, Germany. It is based on a family tree that originated with one prepared by Stefan Aßman of Meudt and included in *900 Jahre Meudt 1097 - 1997* edited by Stefan Aßman, Wolf-Dieter Endlein, Helge Roos, Günter Steigerwald, Bernhard Wirth and Antonius Wolf. The resultant tree is the consolidated work of many, including members of Geni.com and Ancestry.com, individual family members, and especially the efforts of cousins Sally Bruckheimer, Gerald Stern and Ted Tobias.

As research continues, I intend to periodically update this report. I will be happy to act as a clearing house for other researchers so that their information can be included in the whole.

As in all genealogical work, there are errors and omissions. There are examples of information later proved incorrect even in credible resources like the Gedenkbuch. Please report any disputed information so that corrections can be incorporated in future editions, or, if a resolution cannot be found, so that the dispute can be noted. This report includes:

- [A list of the 142 victims of the Holocaust](#) developed from research tools identified below. Source footnotes are at the end of this list. Each individual is indicated as follows:
 - **Perished in Holocaust:** A source reports that the individual died. The date and place of death is usually included.

- **Perished in Holocaust: Suicide:** A source reports that the individual committed suicide. The date and place of death is usually included. It is thought that many of these individuals were actually murdered, but reported as suicides.
- **Presumed Perished in Holocaust:** A source reports that the individual was deported to one or a sequence of camps but does not include information on their death. The date of death is listed as a range from the date of last transport to 1945.
- A list of the 200 family members whose fate in the Holocaust is unknown. This was assembled by identifying those likely in Europe in the 1930s and eliminating those whose fate could be determined. Source footnotes are at the end of this list. The information on these individuals is quite limited; any additional facts that may be helpful in determining their fate.
- An index of all family members mentioned in this report appears at the end.

A register of the descendants of Jakob and Sara is available. I will provide it upon request with the condition that information on any living individuals may not be posted on the Internet and must be kept private.


The Dynasty of Jakob Moyses and Sara of Meudt

the evolution of CAHN, HEILBERG, LAHRHEIM, LÖWENSTEIN and STERN Families

PATRONYMIC NAMES – originally, the Jews used Patronymic names. For example - Jakob Moses (was Jakob son of Moses). During the period between about 1810 and 1840 the Jews were forced to take family names. These were chosen by families for varying reasons. Sometimes they related to their profession or the town they lived in (perhaps Lahrheim for example relates to Lahr, the birthplace of Breille Löb Katz). In this family the Cahn and Stern names were of course taken by the husbands of Minckel or Mina David and Johanne Haim. However the names Heilberg, Lahrheim and Löwenstein were taken/chosen by the male descendants. We have no way of knowing why they chose these names. This is why there are 5 different family names emanating from the descendants of Jakob Moses and Sara – all one family! Even today experienced researchers who are unaware that Jews used Patronymic names are often confused by this.



Alexander Löser or Leser became **STERN's** male line of forebears were all 'Kohanim', descendants of Aaron and the Priests in the Temple in Jerusalem. Jewish male descendants carry this privilege to this day.

Isaac Meyer (b. 1878) was the eldest brother of Louis Meyer. He was also from Rheinbrohl. End of the 20s, he worked on the farm of his brother in Remagen, because he was very well versed with livestock, particularly cattle. During this time he learned the Baehr born widow Mathilde Meyer (b. 1891), who was the sister of Rosa Meyer. Matilda had a son from his first marriage: Herbert Bahr (b. 1919). Her husband Alfred died Bähr 1922nd

Isaac Meyer married Matilda 1929th A year later a son named Carl was born. The Family lived in the house of Mathilde's parents Mühlenbachstr.29 Abraham Meyer (*

1854) Meyer and Emma nee Moses (* 1863). Isaac operational cattle trade and was the home of his Father-in stables and barn.

The implacable emigrants: Herbert Baehr Herbert Bahr attended Sinziger elementary school, then high school Ahrweiler. He was apparently a good soccer player and joined after 1933 a football team of the League Jewish War Veterans of because he was excluded from other clubs. The Gymnasium Herbert had in 1933 because of the "Law against the Overcrowding of German Schools and Universities" leave from 25.04.1933.

Then he gave his uncle Alfred Meyer, an apprenticeship as a plumber or mechanic in Hamburg. This doctrine was the preparation for the planned migration. Before that came, he was arrested together with a namesake in the Sachsenhausen concentration camp admitted. However, he was already three weeks later applied for prior to incarceration Exit visa could, and in 1939 emigrated to England. Once there, he found Working in a defense firm, and was one of the few German immigrants who are not interned were. He was not drafted as a soldier in the British Army. Herbert Baehr lived in London and was several times because of Remagen in restitution and sale of Land and houses, but because of his bad experiences he had an aversion German and wanted to have nothing to do with them.

The deportation of the family of Isaac Meyer Sinzig

Isaac and Matilda Meyer stayed with her son Charles in Remagen, where Carl Catholic in the Kindergarten and later went to elementary school. Witnesses recalled how Carl Meyer One day a policeman was fetched from the instruction. That was 1938, when the Jewish children were forbidden by law to attend public schools. Although in the Kristallnacht in her apartment was massive destruction of what the Family in fear and terrorize, and remained, despite the flight of their relatives Meyers in Remagen. It must be assumed that Mathilde their parents not only in Germany wanted to leave. However, there are indications that the family emigrated Isaac Meyer wanted. But the timing was right apparently missed. So they had all the harassment, can endure, after the Kristallnacht, the Jews and the stigmatized social life were incompatible. Abraham and Emma Meyer died in 1940 and were buried as the last Jew in the Jewish cemetery Sinziger. On 26/04/1942, the family Isaac Meyer picked up in hateful way from his home and together in a special with other Jews of the region from the station first to Sinzig Brohl in the transit camp Brohleck deported from there a few days later they were taken to Koblenz and a transport of 1,000 Jews fed to 30.4.1942 after Krasniczyn (circle Kranystaw, Lublin district lacked). After that, lose track of those deported to the gas chambers the extermination camp at Belzec and Sobibor.

Julius Meyer (b. 1912) was the second exile of the Meyer family. He was obviously a Generation of young Jews who recognized early on that they had no future in Germany, and therefore were willing to seek their chance abroad.
