

## The short history of the ROTHSCHILD family - Gilserberg/Hesse

**1 SALOMON ELIAS** was married to **HINDEL**.

**2 LOESER SALOMON** was son of Salomon Elias and Hindel. In 1773 he was born in Diemelsdorf in the Bamberg area, which probably means Dietersdorf near Coburg (Bavaria). In Gilserberg he stayed since 1795. During the French reign of Northern Hesse Loeser Salomon chose the name **LEYSER ROTHSCHILD**. He had neither a protection paper nor a paper of tolerance, but was named as citizen in Gilserberg. Leyser Rothschild peddled goods, spices and tobacco. It seems that he was successful in his profession, for in 1816 he was helped by the fifteen years old Levi Heskias from Wohra. Beside that profession Leyser Rothschild was first prayer of the Jewish community of Gilserberg. On 03 Jul 1808 the announcement of the marriage of Leyser Rothschild with **SCHOENGEN HERZ** was made. She is identical with Schoengen Liebmann/**SCHEINE STERN**, daughter of Hirsch Liebmann/Herz Stern and Frommet. Scheine Stern was born in Gilserberg in 1781. The couple had eight children. Scheine Rothschild died on 11 Apr 1834 in Gilserberg at the age of 53 years, Leyser Rothschild died there on 22 Apr 1834 at the age of 69 years, 5 month and 29 days. By that information Leyser Rothschild was born on 27 Oct 1765. Both were buried in the Jewish cemetery of Hatzbach (mainly destroyed).

**4 FROMET ROTHSCHILD** was born in 1812 in Gilserberg as daughter of Leyser Rothschild and Scheine Stern. She married on 05 Dec 1838 in Gilserberg the mercer **ABRAHAM SCHWALM**, born on 04 May 1811 in Treysa as son of Salomon Abraham Schwalm and Sara Michel. The couple had less two children. Abraham Schwalm died on 20 Sep 1848 in Treysa. In 1868 Fromet Rothschild Schwalm followed her son Michel Schwalm in emigration, who had been emigrating already in 1866.

**5 FRATCHEN ROTHSCHILD** was born in 1812 in Gilserberg as daughter of Leyser Rothschild and Scheine Stern. She married on 15 Nov 1842 the 29 years old **MEIER STERN** from Niederurff<sup>1</sup>, son of the passed away Wolf Stern and Taeubchen Katz.

**6 ROESGEN ROTHSCHILD** was born in 1816 in Gilserberg as daughter of Leyser Rothschild and Scheine Stern. She married on 24 Oct 1843 in Gilserberg the mercer **ISAAK HEILBRUNN/HEILBRON**, born on 07 May 1812 in Schwarzenborn as son of Kusel Jacob Heilbron and Minkche Wallach. The couple lived in Schwarzenborn. Roeschen Heilbrunn died in Schwarzenborn on 09 Feb 1855 at the age of 38 years. She was buried in the Oberaula Jewish cemetery on 11 Feb 1855. Isak Heilbrunn was married a second time on 11 Sep 1855 to Giedel Wallach from Schwarzenborn, daughter of Isak Wallach and Beile Moses.
