**3.** Salomon Meier, born 29.05.1810 in Trendelburg, he accepted th surname Rosenblatt.

Meier Suessmann accepted in 1812 the surname **Rosenblatt.** Gette Herz was married first to **Levi Falk.** Levi and Gette Falk had two sons:

**4. Falke Levi**, born 08.10.1801 in Trendelburg, he accepted in 1812 the surname **Giesberg 5. Levi Levi**, born 12.05.1808 in Trendelburg, he accepted in 1812 the surname **Giesberg**.

**Levi Falk died before 1810.** Gette Falk was married a second time to **Meier Suessmann Rosenblatt.** Falke and Levi Ginsberg were stepsons to Meier Suessmann Rosenblatt. (Hessisches Staatsarchiv Marburg, Bestand 76a, No. 28, lfd. No. 18)

**3. Salomon Shlomo Rosenblatt,** born 29.05.1810 in Trendelburg, he married **Julia N.N.(?).** Salomon and Julia Rosenblatt had three children:

- 7. Josef / Joseph Rosenblatt, born 12.03.1869 in Trendelburg
- 8. Rieckchen Rosenblatt, born 25.09.1871 in Trendelburg.

**5. Levi Giesberg,** born 12.05.1808 in Trendelburg. He married **Rika Heinemann.** Levi and Rika Giesberg had a son:

- 9. Jonas Giesberg, born 02.11.1846 in Trendelburg.
- **6. Minna Rosenblatt,** born 28.02.1857 in Trendelburg, she was married to **Simon Samson** from Essen. Minna Samson dies on 13.11.1937 in Essen, she is buried on the Jewish Cemetery of Essen, Parkstrasse. The inscription reads: "**Mindel, daughter of Shlomo".** So she could be a daughter of Salomon Rosenblatt.
- **7. Josef Rosenblatt,** born 12.03.1869 in Trendelburg, he married **Elizabeth/Frieda Reifenberg,** born 18.11.1877 in Unna, daughter of **Henrietta Herzstein**, born 05.02.1852 in Hildesheim. Josef/Joseph Rosenblatt eimgrated into the USA. He lived in Baltimore and died at the age of 83 years on 15.06.1952 in Mt. Sinai Home in Baltimore MD, indicated by his wife Frieda Reifenberg.

No information about the following two generations. Josef Rosenblatt is the Great Grandfather of **N.N. Rosen.**

**8. Rieckchen Rosenblatt,** born 25.09.1871 in Trendelburg, daughter of Salomon and Julia Rosenblatt. She was married to **Alfred Reifenberg,** born 04.04.1872 in Unna. Rieckchen and

Alfred Reifenberg lived in Paderborn. Alfred Reifenberg was arrested in Buchenwald from 12.11. - 21.11.1938. Rieckchen and Alfred Reifenberg were deported on 31.07.1942 to Theresienstatdt and from there on 23.09.1942 to Treblinka where they were murdered. We don't know the parents of Rieckchen Rosenblatt and possibly Alfred Reifenberg is related to Elizabeth Reifenberg. They are of the same age and both were born in Unna. I found the information in the database of Yad Vashem. The testimony was written in 2004 by their granddaughter **Emily Lewin Kesser,** 10403 Great Arbor Dr., Portomac, MD 20854

**9. Jonas Giesberg,** born 02.11.1846 in Trendelburg. He married on 09.10.1880 **Jettchen Loewenstein,** born 11.07.1857 in Altenheerse, daughter of Samuel Loewenstein and his wife Minna, née Eicholz. Jonas and Jettchen Giesberg lived in Trendelburg Hirststrasse 72. They had eleven children:

- **20. Sally Giesberg,** born 11.03.1898 in Trendelburg

The family moved from Trendelburg to Westhofen. They were deported on 30.04.1942 from Dortmund to Zamosc.
